

# Terms and Conditions 2024

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## Each entrant must agree to the below terms & conditions:

1. The Race is organized Heaton Harriers and AC under UKA laws (UKA Road Race License number **pending**).
2. Each entrant accepts that the organizers of the Heaton Memorial Road Races will not be liable for any loss, damage, action, claim, costs or expenses which may arise in consequence of their participation in this event.
3. Participants must not compete in the race if they are not in good health and will compete at their own risk.
4. Participants agree to have personal details stored on computer for entry processing.
5. We regret that all entry fees are non-refundable and may not be deferred towards a future event.
6. Heaton Harriers and AC retain the right to refuse entry to anyone.
7. Participants must be capable of completing the full distance, start line to finish line. The Heaton Memorial Road Race is a serious road race run under UK Athletics rules and not a sponsored walk: we will not accept entries from people who intend to walk.
8. Competitors in the 10K must be 16 years or over on 10/11/2024.
9. On race day participants must follow all instructions given from the event organizers, marshals, event officials, police, fire and ambulance / AED operatives throughout the duration of the event.
10. Failure to follow event rules/ event official's instruction may result in disqualification, loss of prize money and removal from official results.
11. Race numbers and timing chips will be available for collection from Race HQ at Royal Grammar School, Brandling House, Lambton Road, Jesmond, Newcastle upon Tyne, NE 4DX from approximately 8:30am on Sunday 13 November 2022 for the 10K (see race entry form for details). No numbers or timing chips will be posted out.
12. Race numbers must be worn on the front of your running vest or t-shirt and must not be cut, folded or altered in any way.
13. The race starting area is approximately 500m from Race HQ and all competitors should ensure that they have sufficient time to reach the start in good time.
14. A limited number of entries may be available on 10 November 2024 only if the event is not sold out prior. The Late Entries desk will close at 10:30 prompt unless sold out prior. We would recommend that competitors enter on-line as soon as possible and no later than midnight on Thursday 7 November 2024.
15. A full prize list and list of Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) are published on the Heaton Harriers website.
16. NECAA prizes will be awarded separately to the Heaton Harriers Memorial Prizes and are only open to those individuals who qualify – please see the NECAA qualification requirements.
17. NEMAA prizes will be awarded separately to the Heaton Harriers Memorial Prizes and are only open to NEMAA members.

18. A series of Junior Races will take place prior to the main 10K event as advertised on the entry form and the Heaton Harriers Website.
19. Race Numbers must only be worn by original entrants and transfers will be allowed up to a week before the race.
20. The official 10K race will start after the traditional two minutes silence which will happen at 11:00am. All competitors, spectators and guests are asked to respect the one minutes silence and strictly adhere to it.
21. Running with dogs, prams, pushchairs or similar items is not permitted.
22. Baggage and personal effects may be left at Race HQ at the owner's risk. Members of the race organizer's team will be at Race HQ at all times however there is no official manned storage baggage area.
23. The wearing of musical devices such as iPod and headphones is strictly prohibited.
24. Team prizes will be awarded to the first three male and female club teams. The first four male runners and first four female runners from an individual club will be counted as that club's A Team, the next four male and the next four female runners from a club will be the B team. Each club can win more than one team prize in both the male and female team races.
